Main Program: ASHRAE And Commercial Kitchen Ventilation Design

Commercial kitchen ventilation design must meet the minimum safety requirements by code, but energy efficient design, proper integration with building HVAC, and improved safety are absolutely critical for sustainable designs. ASHRAE has published several works that help guide proper kitchen ventilation design. This presentation will discuss these publications and their relationship to safety requirements, strategies for reducing ventilation rates, use of listed hoods (UL Standard 710), demand ventilation, make up air delivery and tempering, advanced fire safety, and energy considerations.

Speaker: Mr. Sean McGinn – CaptiveAire Inc.

Mr. McGinn graduated from UCF with a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering and has worked for CaptiveAire for a little over 2 years. Sean moved to Ft. Myers from Tampa last March and is one of our newest members in SWFL ASHRAE.
